SHARE OPTIONS (PLEASE CHECK ONE)

Clear Brook Farm Share, \$425 for 12 weeks of produce grown at Clear Brook Farm.

Bread and Egg Share, \$515 the CBF Share **plus** 1 loaf of bread weekly and 1 dozen eggs every other week for 12 weeks.

Localvore Share, \$725 for 12 weeks of CBF Share, Bread and Egg Share, as well as cheese, honey, apples, jam, etc. produced within a 200 mile radius.

Pay \$125 (non-refundable) at sign up, and also provide us with 2 pre-dated (Oct. 10, Nov. 25) checks for the **CBF Share:** \$150/\$150; **Bread and Egg Share:** \$125 plus two checks for \$195/\$195; **Localvore Share** \$125 Plus two checks for \$300/\$300. Clear Brook Farm Winter CSA Information

2010 will be our third season of the Clear Brook Farm Winter Community Sponsored Agriculture (CSA) program. Last year was such a great success that we hope to offer 200 shares this year. The Winter CSA will have a total of 12 pickup weeks (we are adding 2 pickups in January, dates to be determined), Pickups will be weekly mid-October through December (There will be no pickup Thanksgiving week).

Returning members will note that there is a price increase this year. This is a result of having added 2 more pickup weeks in January, and also a realization of all the "hidden" costs and time involved in providing fresh produce in a Vermont winter. We think that if you compare our prices we still remain very competitive with other winter CSA programs in Vermont.

Clear Brook Farm offers **Thursday** pickups at the Farm and at Battenkill Books (*NEW SITE!*) in Cambridge, NY. Our **Saturday** pickups are both at the Farm and at Al Ducci's in Manchester, VT.

**** Pickups** will be **weekly** starting Thursday October 14, and Saturday Oct. 16 thru the end of December with 2 additional pickups in January (exact dates to be determined).

****** If you will be missing a pickup, please find a friend to pick up for you; if that is not possible, let us know, and we will box a share up for you to pick up later in the week.

****** Weekly emails with the week's veggie list, recipes, and general info so you stay connected to the farm.

****** Vegetables grown for the winter: broccoli, cauliflower, fennel, brussel sprouts, collards, kale, bok choy, napa cabbage, green and red cabbage, potatoes, sweet potatoes, celeriac, garlic, leeks, shallots, onions, spinach, arugula, lettuce, swiss chard, beets, carrots, parsnips, rutabagas, storage radishes, daikon, colored peppers (weather permitting), winter squash, cilantro, dry beans, kohlrabi, parsley...

Sample weekly CBF share: swiss chard, brussel sprouts, carrots, kale, beets, lettuce, braising mix, shallots, and buttercup squash.

Sample weekly Bread and Egg share (*new this year!*): the CBF share and a loaf of various breads from around the area as well as a dozen eggs every other week.

Sample weekly Localvore share: includes the CBF share, the Bread and Egg share items plus a rotating variety of local cheeses, Scott Farm apples, State Line Farm maple syrup, Butterworks yogurt, Vermont Soy products, Berle Farm cheese/yogurt, jam, and more!
